What is modified constraint induced movement therapy (mCIMT)?

- mCIMT involves restraining the unaffected arm while engaging the affected limb in a range of everyday activities

Who can participate?

- Children with Hemiplegia ages 5-9
- In person camp 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. Caregivers will also sign up for 30 minute caregiver coaching session (scheduled at registration) from 11:30 a.m. - 12 p.m. one day in the camp week.
- Children must be able to participate independently in group activities with therapist assist and verbal cueing

What to bring?

- Water and a peanut-free snack
- Indoor shoes and constraint splint
- Sunscreen for outdoor activities (weather permitting)
- Mask friendly Setting
