




NBS Kids Adaptive Dance Program



Come Dance with us this Fall!

Registration for our 2023/2024 programming is now open.

Term one: September 17-December 10, 2023.

The NBS Kids – Adaptive Dance Program was created by Canada's National Ballet School (NBS), in consultation with Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital. The program offers adapted creative movement classes for children ages 3-18 with diverse physical, developmental and sensory needs. Our program is centered around fostering a love of dance, and our dancers are welcomed to engage in the class in a way that feels right to them.

Each class is led by an NBS Community Dance Educator and supported by a live accompanist. All of our **creative 1** programming is accompanied by an Occupational Therapist and a team of volunteers that provide 1:1 support throughout class. While our **creative 2** programming is tailored toward dancers who are both ready and working towards participating more independently in programming, with volunteers present to support.

Programming runs from 9:45am-2:15pm on Sundays, with seven different classes to choose from.
