Accessing Private Occupational Therapy

Your child is on a waitlist for occupational therapy services at school. This service is provided free of charge and is part of the provincially funded School Based Rehabilitation Services program.


While you wait, private (pay-for-service) occupational therapy may be available. A doctor's referral is not required to access an Occupational Therapist and some families may have access to insurance coverage to cover the cost of these services. It is important to check with your insurance provider to see how much coverage they provide and how payments are made before starting with an Occupational Therapist.
