Creative movement - 1

Primary (ages 4+) Sundays 9:45am- 10:30am Junior (ages 9+) Sundays 11:00am-11:45am

This stream provides one-on-one support throughout the duration of class and moves at a slower pace. These classes are led by an NBS Community Dance Specialist and supported by a live accompanist, an Occupational Therapist and a team of volunteers.

Creative movement - 2

Primary (ages 4+) Sundays 12:15pm- 1:00pm Junior (ages 9+) Sundays 1:30pm- 2:15pm

This stream is a moderate to fast-paced class and a good fit for children who are both ready and working towards two step instructions and participating independently in programming. These classes are led by an NBS Community Dance Specialist and supported by a live accompanist, an Occupational Therapist and a team of volunteers.
