## **Come Dance with us!**

The NBS Kids – Adaptive Dance Program was created by Canada's National Ballet School (NBS), in consultation with Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital and offers adapted creative movement classes for participants ages three to adult with diverse physical, developmental and sensory needs. This program is centred on fostering a love for dance and dancers are welcome to engage in the class in a way that feels right to them.

Each class is led by an NBS Community Dance Educator and supported by a live accompanist. We offer 3 streams of programming with eight classes, spanning from primary grades to high school.



Our Family Creative Movement and Music program is accompanied by a Music Therapist and is for dancers ages 3-5 and their grown-ups to participate in dance classes together.

Our **Creative 1** program is for dancers ages 5+, accompanied by an Occupational Therapist and a team of volunteers that provide 1:1 support throughout class.

Our Creative 2 program is for dancers ages 5+ and is tailored toward dancers who are both ready and working towards participating more independently in programming with volunteers present to support.

## Why Dance?

- Builds on creativity
- Opportunities for self-expression through movement
- Opportunity to explore new sensory inputs
- Builds self-confidence
- Encourages independence and leadership
- Opportunity for socialisation with peers
- Promotes physical activity, physical literacy skills and body awareness

Programming runs from 9:45am-3:30pm on Sundays, with nine different classes to choose from.
